


**Precision Software Announces Release of PRECISION 2009**

**PRECISION 2009 Detail:**

**Workflow Available in the Web User Interface.** Workflow is an integral part of Precision’s solution and until now has only been available through the Windows UI. This release introduces a subset of the Workflow functionality within the Web UI and will be extended further in the next releases (there are two planned before the end of 2010), to provide the same level of functionality as is available in the Windows UI.

## Precision Software Announces Release of PRECISION 2009

**New and Extended Carrier Integrations.** PRECISION continues to maintain carrier certifications and add to the network of carriers, country origins and services available around the world. Examples of updates to our Carrier Integrations are as follows:

- Re-Certification with UPS 2010 (US and Canada), USPS, and Purolator (Canada)
- New carrier/origin support for "No Limit" (Netherlands), DSV/Franz Mass (Germany), GLS (France) and UPS (France, Ireland & South Africa)
- New carrier services for DHL, TNT, and UPS (Paperless Invoice)

**Routing Guide Enhancements.** The concept of 'branching' has been introduced to the Routing Guide to simplify the setup and maintenance of complex routing decisions; i.e., routing rules can be hierarchical. Additionally routing decisions based on required delivery date and time have been improved and include support for non-transit days. The Routing Guide has been extended so that it can be used to determine the Shipping Date based on preferred Service and required delivery date and time.

**Unicode support throughout the application.** While TRAXi3 offered multi-lingual support (with Western European languages as the norm), there were restrictions with language support, particularly in the area of double byte languages (e.g., Japanese). With PRECISION 2009, the language restrictions have been removed and the solution is fully Unicode compliant including screens / literals, data entry fields, documents, labels and electronic communications with other systems and external parties.

### **Support for the European Export Control System (ECS).**

PRECISION's European customs integrations have been updated to support the new European Union electronic customs requirements that became mandatory for most countries in July 2009. While each EU country has its own automated export system (e.g., ATLAS in Germany and AEP in Ireland), there were also requirements introduced in relation to reporting "indirect exports," or shipments made in one country that travel to another member state before export (such as shipping from Dublin, Ireland to the United States via Rotterdam, Netherlands).

Customs integrations that are currently supported by PRECISION include:

- AEP - Ireland
- AES - United States
- ATLAS - Germany
- NES - United Kingdom
- SAGITTA – Netherlands
